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To ensure confidentiality, data should be presented without any personally identifiable information (e.g., student/teacher names, dates of birth, student ID numbers, etc.) To better understand the trends that exist in your school, in addition to 2022-23 data, if Teams may also find the Department's resources on <u>Culturally Relevant and Sustaining Practices</u> and the Board of Regents' <u>Framework on Diversity</u>, <u>Equity</u>, and <u>Inclusion in New York's Schools</u>: <u>A Call to Action</u> useful in exploring this topic further.

- 1. Provide one of the data sets you will use, along with the <u>Data Analysis worksheet</u>.
 - Ensure that the participants understand the information presented and how to review it.
 - Review the Data Analysis worksheet and question prompts. Emphasize the entries in the "Notice" column should be limited to facts about the data, rather than speculations.
 - o Caution the use of terms
